

Dear Athletic Directors/Nurses/School Personnel,

The Scottsdale Unified School District is now offering voluntary student accident and health insurance to your schools through UnitedHealthcare StudentResources. Because our policy year differs from the company you are currently using, any summer activities will be considered part of the 2008-2009 school year. The new policy year will begin the first day of your school year, Aug. 10, 2009. (Except H.S. Football, which begins Aug. 1st.)

Students will need to purchase 24 Hour Summer Only if they are wanting coverage for summer time activities and programs going on this coming summer. This will cover them 24 hours a day from the last day of the 2008 school year to the first day of the 2009 school year.

High school football players who have just completed 9-11 grade, can purchase the Spring Football to cover them for weightlifting, conditioning, and AIA sanctioned camps for this coming summer. (Students who have just completed 8th grade but are conditioning with the high school team can purchase 24 Hour Summer Only to be covered)

All players will have to purchase the regular Football coverage to be covered for the 2009-2010 football season, (Aug 1st) and that will cover them all through the entire season, weightlifting, and summer conditioning for the 09-'10 school year.

The Student Health Plan covers injury and sickness (excluding interscholastic sports coverage) and is available for 5-18 year olds only. It may be purchased for \$98.00 bi-monthly, however parents need to keep in mind that the policy year ends in July so that will be their last month of coverage whether they get a full 2 months of coverage or not. They can continue coverage in Aug. to keep their child from lapsing in coverage.

Once the new policy year begins, all coverages will be available for purchase. At-School will cover a child from the first day of the school year to the last day of school during the time they are at school or participating in a school sponsored and supervised activity. 24 Hour will cover them from the first day of school to the first day of the following school year, so if they purchase that this year, they will not need the 24 Summer Only next summer. Extended dental is available with these 2 plans *and* the Football plan for \$7.00 extra. Pre-schoolers who are part of the school system, are eligible for the accident plans. All prices, except the health plan, are one time yearly premiums. To allow parents to get the most coverage for their money, the student brochures should be mailed out or sent home on or before the first day of school. Please advise parents **not to send cash**. The company will not be responsible for lost cash payments.

Parents can also enroll online by visiting www.K12studentinsurance.com. This is the fastest method of enrolling, as students can be covered within 24 hours. The schools are encouraged to post this link onto your websites. Parents can obtain a claim form and instructions on how to file a claim, from our website if their child is injured.

A health plan flyer and our basic flyer will be included in this email for you to post in your school offices.

Should you need field trip coverage throughout the school year, a field trip rider is available to cover students on school sponsored and supervised field trips. Benefits will be paid under our Middle Option.

One day field trips are .35 per participant, overnight field trips 5 nights or less are 2.00 per participant for the entire duration and over 5 nights are 1.00 per participant per day. All participants must be covered, and travel to and from must be in a school furnished vehicle. Field trip rider and payment must be in our office prior to the date of the trip.
